LOCATION | SOIL | WATER

The Lind Ranch's Syrah vineyard is located at 3600 W. Peltier Road, Lodi, CA 95242.

- Major cross streets: W. Peltier Road and DeVries Road
- AVA: Lodi | Sub-AVA: Mokelumne River
- Climate: Mediterranean
- Soil: Grown on classic sandy loam (Kingdom Fine Sand, Tokay Fine Sandy) soils, our vines benefit from deep roots, excellent drainage, and a balanced, low-input farming system.
- Planted: 2000 | Grafted from the original Phillips Farm Syrah vineyard owned by Michael David Winery.
- Acreage: 15 acres
- Spacing: 6' x 8'
- Trellis: Double, wire
- Average Tonnage: 90 - 110 tons
- **Available Tons in 2025: 50 tons**



SUSTAINABLE VITICULTURE

- Organic fertilizer
- Solar powered vineyard property
- Rows mowed.
- Round-up free for over 2 years.
- Drip irrigation by surface water
- Limited pesticide use, relying instead on sulphur and diatomaceous earth as needed to maintain vine health without compromising ecosystem integrity.
- Certified sustainable by Lodi Rules since 2013.



HISTORY

The vineyard was part of the Lind family's American dream. Two generations of the family lived and worked the vineyards, starting with Roy Lind in the 1970's. An industrious and diversified farmer, Roy also raised poultry and used the manure as organic fertilizer for the vineyards. A practice still in place today.

The property remained in the Lind family until 2006 when Leonard and Alyce Peterson acquired the property through their company, L.A. Delta Investments, Inc.
